

Enable local ssl for OMV on MacOS Catalina

Before upgrading the iMac to catalina and therefore safari, an option was given to trust certificates. However, this option is no longer available.

So how to establish a secure ssl connection for OpenMediaVault?

First enable the ssh connection through OpenMediaVault.

Move on through the process of identity exchange on the terminal, and log in with the root password.

Copy one of the self made certificates, through the scp command. From OMV to the Mac.

Open the key chain app on Mac and import the certificate. Double click on the certificate to open. Click on the trust arrow and select always trust.

The Mac will ask for password, enter it.

The WebGUI of OMV now has a ssl secure connection connection on MacOS.

Note:

*Look out for key-size while creating the certificate on OMV, not all key sizes may be supported on the other computer.
